Moving your vehicle is also a requirement under the Town of Ponoka's Traffic Bylaw No. 388-17 and may result in fines and the towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense if needed.

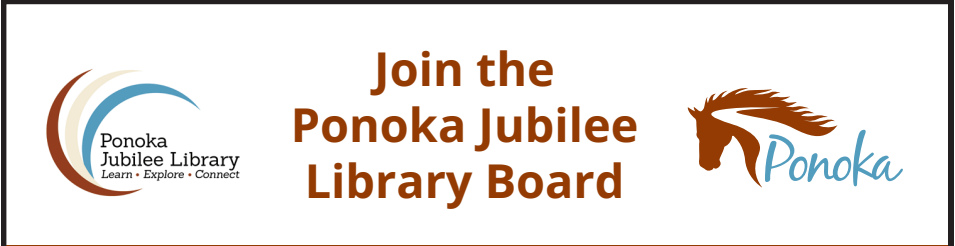
