6.1 **Purchasing Policy**

Council approved the CP-24 Purchasing Policy. The policy has been updated to ensure the Town's procurement practices remain transparent, accountable, and compliant with applicable laws while aligning with strategic objectives and modern administrative practices.

Council made a motion to table the request for proclamation for National Depression Screening Day. The request for proclamation will be brought back to the September 9 Regular Council Meeting for further discussion and consideration.
