- Ponoka Stampede Parade June 30 Don't miss the annual Ponoka Stampede Parade (hosted by the Ponoka Stampede and Exhibition Association) as it rolls through Town on Friday, June 30 at 10 a.m.
  - The parade begins at the Ponoka Arena Complex and loops through the downtown area heading north on 51 Street, east on 57 Avenue and then south along 50 Street as it returns to the Arena.
  - The following roadways will be temporarily closed for the parade between about 9 a.m. and 12 p.m.: 55 Street (from 45 Avenue to 48 Avenue); 48 Avenue (from 55 Street to 51 Street); 51 Street (from 48 Avenue to 57 Avenue); 57 Avenue (from 51 Street to 50 Street); 50 Street (from 57 Avenue to 46 Avenue); 46 Avenue (from 50 Street to 54 Street); and 54 Street (from 46 Avenue to 45 Avenue).

If you provide your email address, you will also receive notification when your request has been completed.
- **Grey Carts and Green Carts** should be placed at the curb for pick up on June 14, 15 and 16 depending on your Zone.
- Green Carts and Recyclable Materials bundled in clear or blue transparent plastic bags should be placed at the curb for pick up on June 21, 22 and 23 depending on what Zone you live in.
- Missed Pickups If your curbside recycling, compost (green cart) or waste (grey cart) was not picked up on your designated collection day, please contact E360S dispatch at 403-341-9300 or by email at rddispatch@e360s.ca.
