If you have not received your 2023 assessment and tax notice, please contact the Tax Clerk at 403-783-0127 or by email at taxes@ponoka.ca.



The Town of Ponoka 2023 combined assessment and property tax notices have been mailed or emailed to all property owners in Ponoka.



All property owners are responsible to ensure their taxes are paid on time and to contact the Town if they do not receive their tax notice.

In accordance with the Municipal Government Act, all assessed persons are deemed to have received their assessment and tax notices seven days after it is sent. 2023 assessments and tax notices were mailed or sent by electronic means on Wednesday, May 24, 2023.



Citizens have until Monday, July 31, 2023 to pay property taxes without penalty.

- **Payment Dates for Monthly Property Tax Payment Plan** - Citizens who pay their property taxes through the Town of Ponoka's Monthly Property Tax Payment Plan can now select a payment date of either the first or 16th day of each month. To change your payment date or to ask questions, please contact the Town Tax Clerk at 403-783-0127 or email taxes@ponoka.ca.
- **Grey Carts and Green Carts** should be placed at the curb for pick up on July 12, 13 and 14 – depending on your Zone.
- **Green Carts and Recyclable Materials** bundled in clear or blue transparent plastic bags should be placed at the curb for pick up on July 19, 20 and 21- depending on what Zone you live in.
- **Missed Pickups** – If your curbside recycling, compost (green cart) or waste (grey cart) was not picked up on your designated collection day, please contact E360S dispatch at 403-341-9300 or by email at rddispatch@e360s.ca.
