Town of Ponoka snow and ice control crews are busy sanding and clearing snow on priority routes throughout the community today (Friday, March 28). Crews are also sanding and clearing snow from sidewalks adjacent to Town-owned properties and on walking trails in Town parks and throughout the trail system.

Motorists are encouraged to slow down and drive for winter conditions. Snow and ice control crews will continue to monitor intersections and roadways throughout the community and respond as needed.
