Annual Fall Clean Up Happening October 11

The Town of Ponoka's annual back-alley collection of compostable yard waste begins Tuesday, October 11 and will continue until each back alley is completed. The Town will make one pass down each back alley in Ponoka to collect yard waste (grass clippings, leaves, weeds and branches less than five feet) in excess of what will fit into residents' green carts.

Please place compostable yard waste you would like picked up in a pile on your property in the back alley no later than Monday, October 10. If you do not have a back alley, please put the yard waste near the curb at the front of your property for pick up.

No Bags Please

Please do not bag the yard waste. Compostable yard waste piles with plastic bags will not be picked up.

Materials that will be picked up are: compostable yard waste and tree branches no longer than five feet.

Materials that will not be picked up are: garbage/household waste, plastic, rocks, construction material, wood, and pet excrement.

Residents are also welcome to take compostable yard waste to the Town of Ponoka Waste Transfer Station free of charge.
