


If you have not received your 2023 assessment and tax notice, please contact the Tax Clerk at 403-783-0127 or by email at taxes@ponoka.ca.



The Town of Ponoka 2023 combined assessment and property tax notices have been mailed or emailed to all property owners in Ponoka.



All property owners are responsible to ensure their taxes are paid on time and to contact the Town if they do not receive their tax notice.

In accordance with the Municipal Government Act, all assessed persons are deemed to have received their assessment and tax notices seven days after it is sent. 2023 assessments and tax notices were mailed or sent by electronic means on Wednesday, May 24, 2023.



Citizens have until Monday, July 31, 2023 to pay property taxes without penalty.
