### Town Office at Ponoka Civic Centre

Notice of Increase to the Franchise Fee on Natural Gas Billings

The Town of Ponoka is proposing to increase the natural gas distribution franchise fee which it charges ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. for the exclusive right to deliver natural gas to the residents of Ponoka and for use of municipal lands for its natural gas lines, effective February 1, 2023.

The franchise fee applies to all customers that receive gas services in Ponoka and is required to be billed as a separate charge on gas billings. The current franchise fee is set at 23 per cent of ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. delivery revenues and will increase to 27 per cent effective February 1, 2023.

For an average residential customer using 115 GJs per year, this will result in an annual increase of approximately \$26.43 from the average that would otherwise be paid in 2023. The franchise fee is anticipated to account for approximately \$178.38 of the average annual residential bill in 2023.

- Please Watch for No Parking Signs With snow and ice control operations ongoing throughout the winter, motorists are asked to please watch for 'No Parking' signs and move parked vehicles from roadways where 'No Parking' signage is posted. Moving parked vehicles from roadways allows crews to conduct snow and ice control operations more safely and efficiently. Moving your vehicle is also a requirement under the Town of Ponoka's Traffic Bylaw No. 388-17 and may result in fines and the towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense if needed.
- **Grey Carts and Green Carts** should be placed at the curb for pick up on December 14, 15 and 16 depending on your Zone.
- **Recyclable Materials** bundled in clear or blue transparent plastic bags should be placed at the curb for pick up on December 21, 22 and 23 depending on what Zone you live in.
