



Town of Ponoka Snow and Ice Control Update – December 18, 2025

Please watch for 'No Parking' Signs

Town of Ponoka snow and ice control crews are continuing to clear snow and sanding roadways throughout the community. Crews are also sanding and clearing snow from sidewalks adjacent to Town-owned properties and on walking trails in Town parks and throughout the trail system this week.

Snow Removal in the Downtown Core (Zone 6)

Snow removal operations will begin in the downtown **tomorrow, December 19** along the following roadways:

- 48 Avenue between 50 Street and 54 Street;
- 49 Avenue between 50 Street and 51 Street;
- 50 Avenue between 50 Street and 52 Street;
- 51 Avenue between 50 Street and 52 Street;
- 50 Street between 48 Avenue and 53 Avenue; and
- 51 Street between 48 Avenue and 53 Avenue.

Please note that changing weather conditions and new snowfall events can require crews to direct their attention back to priority routes and delay planned snow removal operations. As a result, crews may not complete all roadways in the zone and will return at a later date.

'No Parking' Signs

Please watch for 'No Parking' signs and move parked vehicles from roads when the signs are posted.

Removing your vehicle from the roadway when 'No Parking' signs are posted in advance of snow removal operations is a requirement under the Town's Traffic Bylaw and can result in fines and towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense if needed.

How to Report an Icy Intersection or Sidewalk
