# It's Time to Renew Your **Business Licence**

Businesses in the Town of Ponoka have until **December 31. 2022** to renew their business licence for the 2023 year.

Businesses that operate, provide or sell a product or service within or partially within the Town of Ponoka corporate boundaries are required to possess a valid Ponoka business licence.

Business licences must be renewed annually. Approved business licences for the 2022 year will expire on December 31, 2022.

- **Temporary Ponoka Aquaplex Closure** The Ponoka Aquaplex will be temporarily closed on Sunday, November 6 for routine maintenance. The facility will reopen for regular hours of operation on Monday, November 7.
- Remembrance Day Service and Parade The Ponoka Legion will host its annual Remembrance Day parade on November 11 at 10:15 a.m. The parade will begin at the ATCO building (#1, 4213, Highway 2A) and end at the Ponoka Legion (3911, Highway 2A). The Legion's annual Remembrance Day service will follow.
- Town Facility Hours All Town facilities will be closed on Friday, November 11 for the Remembrance Day statutory holiday. Regular hours will resume on Monday, November 14.
- Green Carts Switch to Winter Pick Up Schedule Curbside pick up of Green Cart compost waste has switched to the winter pick up schedule (every second week) until April 30, 2023 when it will revert back to weekly pick up for the spring and summer season.
- Waste Transfer Station Switches to Winter Hours The Waste Transfer Station has now switched to winter hours, which are Tuesday to Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to
- Grey Carts and Green Carts should be placed at the curb for pick up on November 2, 3 and 4 – depending on your Zone.
- Recyclable Materials bundled in clear or blue transparent plastic bags should be placed at the curb for pick up on November 9, 10 and 11 - depending on what Zone
