

Town of Ponoka Street Sweeping Begins this Week

(April 16, 2025– Ponoka, Alberta) – The Town of Ponoka begins street sweeping operations this week on Town roadways downtown and along major routes.

Residential Street Sweeping

Street sweeping will expand into residential areas in the coming weeks. At that time, community advisory signs will be placed in neighbourhoods 48 hours before street sweeping occurs to give residents advance notice.

'No Parking' Signs

'No Parking' signs will be placed along roadways the day before street sweeping is scheduled to happen on a particular street.

Please move parked vehicles from roadways when 'no parking' signs are posted. This is a requirement under the Town's Traffic Bylaw 388-17 and may result in fines and towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense if needed.

Moving parked vehicles from roadways allows crews to conduct street sweeping operations safely and more efficiently.

Street sweeping is weather permitting and may be interrupted due to inclement weather. Please remain a safe distance from street sweepers and take alternate routes to avoid street sweeping equipment where possible.
