On the third floor of the Ponoka Civic Centre (#200, 5604 50 Street).


We want your feedback on the major policy direction that has been drafted for the new Municipal Development Plan (MDP).

- Fire Advisory in Effect The Town of Ponoka is currently under a Fire Advisory, with the following now permitted to be used: bylaw compliant fire pits (with the screen in place), portable propane fire pits and appliances; and barbecues and smokers using charcoal and pellets. - Town of Ponoka Celebrates Pride Month As part of its commitment to being a welcoming, inclusive and caring community, the Town of Ponoka will be celebrating Pride Month once again this year by projecting the pride colours onto the outside of the Ponoka Civic Centre each evening in June from sunset until sunrise. The Town of Ponoka is also one of many sponsors of the Pride in the Park event on Saturday, June 10 from 12 to 4 p.m. at Lions Centennial Park.
- Redevelopment of 51 Avenue Project Update Work on phase two of the 51 Avenue Redevelopment Project is continuing. Since work commenced on May 8, the temporary sidewalk on the north side of the street has been removed and the contractor is in the process of constructing the new permanent sidewalk. During this time, crews are working to minimize two-way traffic interruptions and on street parking restrictions as much as possible. Motorists are asked to please drive with caution in the area and watch for posted signs and traffic safety personnel.
