Please place your Christmas tree for pick up at your back alley no later than Monday, January 22.

If you do not have a back alley, please place your Christmas tree near the curb at the front of your property, ensuring it is visible for pick up.

Please note that weather conditions can delay Christmas tree pick up as Town crews may have to divert their attention to snow and ice control operations.

You can also take your compostable tree to the Waste Transfer Station free of charge.
