- Ponoka Stampede Traffic Accommodations The Town of Ponoka, in cooperation with Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors, will once again be implementing its annual traffic control plan to help ensure pedestrian and vehicle safety during the Ponoka Stampede. - Ponoka Civic Cente Lit Up Throughout June Throughout June, the exterior of the Ponoka Civic Centre (5604 50 Street) will be lit up with coloured lights from sunset to sunrise to recognize the following events:
 - June 9 to 15 Pride Month: Pride lights will be projected onto the building this week to celebrate Pride Month, as part of the Town's commitment to being a welcoming, inclusive and caring community.
 - June 16 to 22 National Indigenous History Month and National Indigenous Peoples Day: The colour orange will be reflected onto the outside of the building this week in the spirit of reconciliation and to recognize National Indigenous History Month and National Indigenous Peoples Day on June 21.
 - June 23 to July 1 Canada Day: The colour red will be projected onto the exterior of the building this week to mark Canada Day on July 1.
