- Residential New Build Incentive:** for new or existing residents who build or buy a newly-built home not previously occupied in the Town of Ponoka in 2025.
- Commercial New Build Incentive:** for commercial businesses that build a new property in 2025 in the Town of Ponoka on commercially-zoned land.
- Major Home Renovation Program:** for Ponoka residents who complete major renovations on their home in 2025, which increase their property's assessment value by at least 20 per cent (excluding land assessment value).
