



Town of Ponoka Street Sweeping Update – May 16, 2023

(May 16, 2023 – Ponoka, Alberta) – Town of Ponoka annual street sweeping operations continue today to remove the sanding material, dirt and debris that has been deposited on Town roadways over the winter.

Street sweeping will continue throughout the week (weather permitting) in the following areas:

- Central District (Zone 3) and Downtown Core (Zone 6) on Tuesday, May 16;
- Riverside (Zone 4) on Wednesday, May 17; and
- Lucas Heights (Zone 1) on Thursday, May 18.

Please Watch for ‘No Parking’ Signs and Move Parked Vehicles

Please watch for ‘no parking’ signs and move parked vehicles from roadways on which ‘no parking’ signage is posted. Moving parked vehicles from roadways allows crews to conduct street sweeping operations safely and more efficiently. Please note that vehicles only need to be removed from the roadway if ‘no parking’ signage is posted along that particular street.

Removing your parked vehicle from roadways on which ‘no parking’ signage is posted in advance of street sweeping operations is a requirement under the Town’s Traffic Bylaw 388-17 and may result in fines and towing of the vehicle at the owner’s expense if needed.

Motorists are advised to keep a safe distance from the street sweeper and take alternate routes to avoid street sweeping equipment where possible.

How to Stay Informed About Street Sweeping

Street sweeping updates will be posted regularly to the Town of Ponoka website at www.ponoka.ca and on social media (Facebook, Twitter and Instagram) @TownofPonoka. Street sweeping is weather permitting and may be interrupted due to inclement weather.

Please note that Highway 2A and Highway 53 are provincial roadways that are maintained by the Alberta Ministry of Transportation’s highway contractor, Mainroad Alberta Ltd.
