Ponoka Stampede Traffic Control Plan

The following traffic control measures will be in effect from Monday, June 23 to Wednesday, July 2, effective 24 hours daily during the 2025 Ponoka Stampede.

- A reduced traffic speed limit of 30 km/ hr along Highway 53 – Beginning east of Highway 2A and ending at 46 Street.
- A reduced traffic speed limit of 50 km/ hr along Highway 2A – Beginning south of 36 Avenue to the intersection of Highways 2A and 53.
- A temporary four-way stop at Highway
 53 and 50 Street Advanced signage will notify motorists east and west of the four-way stop at the intersection of 50 Street and Highway
 53. The access road to the Stampede grounds will be temporarily open to traffic at that intersection, making it a four-way stop.
- Access to Highway 53 will be closed to traffic at 54 Street 54 Street will remain open to local traffic and users of the Ponoka Arena Complex; however, access to Highway 53 will be blocked to traffic at the south end of 54 Street.
- RCMP will monitor and help direct pedestrian and vehicle traffic as needed.
