



Ponoka Aquaplex Reopening for Swim Lessons and Private Bookings with Restrictions Due to COVID-19

Pool Users Will Be Welcomed Back to Newly Resurfaced Pool Deck and Wading Pool

(April 6, 2021 – Ponoka, Alberta) – With extensive maintenance and facility improvements now completed, the Ponoka Aquaplex is reopening this week for limited public use with restrictions in place due to COVID-19. The pool will be open for small-group swim lessons, private and semi-private lessons, Junior Lifeguard Club (JLC) and private facility rentals in accordance with provincial health regulations and guidelines.

“We are excited to welcome pool users back to the Aquaplex and show them the extensive improvements and upgrades that we’ve been working on,” said Andrew Jones, Recreation Coordinator for the Town of Ponoka. “It really does look and feel like a different facility and we’re excited to show it off,” said Jones.

The improvements and upgrades that have been completed at the Aquaplex include:

- A completely resurfaced and refinished pool deck with a new thermoplastic, slip-resistant coating;
- A fully resurfaced and refurbished wading pool with a durable new thermoplastic coating for a smoother, more comfortable user experience for families and children enjoying the wading pool;
- A new rooftop HVAC system that regulates airflow, temperature and humidity for greater comfort and user enjoyment at the Aquaplex;
- New edging around the main pool, deep tank and wading pool;
- New depth markers around the deep tank and main pool; and
- Painting and general maintenance throughout the facility.

Swim Lessons and Junior Lifeguard Club Begin April 16

Registration is open for Junior Lifeguard Club and swim lessons for Pre-school levels up to Swim Kids 6. Swimming lessons and JLC classes begin April 16. Only three or four children will be permitted in each swimming lesson due to provincial COVID-19 restrictions. A caregiver, aged 16 or older, will be required to accompany children into the water for all Pre-school lessons and Swim Kids 1-4.

All lessons and rentals must be booked in advance. Private Lessons

Private facility rentals as well as one-hour private and semi-private lessons are available beginning April 7. Private facility rentals have been reduced in price from \$110 per hour to \$46 to encourage more families to use the Aquaplex on weekdays. Only guests living in the same household are permitted to share a private booking.

Additional COVID-19 Measures

To help protect the health and safety of visitors and Aquaplex staff, the following additional COVID-19 safety measures will be in place to help prevent the spread of the virus:

- Swimmers are asked to arrive no more than five minutes before their scheduled times;
- Guests are required to come dressed for swimming as change room and locker access will not be available prior to using the pools;
- Swimmers will be required to have a soapy shower on the pool deck before entering the pools;
- Occupancy limits will be in place for the pools and deck, along with one-way traffic flow measures for the lobby and pool deck;
- There will be time-limited access to change rooms upon leaving the pools and blow dryers are not permitted;
- Facility users will be required to use available hand sanitizer upon entering the building and follow physical distancing requirements;
- Aquaplex users must sign in at reception to ensure contact information is available for notification purposes should an outbreak occur;
- Visitors at Town facilities are urged to stay home if they have flu-like symptoms such as fever, cough, runny nose, sore throat or shortness of breath; if they have travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days; or if they have been in close contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19.
