



## **Waste & Recycling Program Public Open House**

### ***Citizen Input Survey results from Program Review survey conducted in Spring 2018***

**Of almost 300 Ponoka citizens who completed the  
Citizen Input Survey:**

- 1. About 70% are recycling more since the current Waste Management & Recycling Program was launched in 2016.**
- 2. More than 50% are setting out less garbage at the curb since the current program started.**
- 3. About 60% are satisfied with the current system of bi-weekly garbage pickup.**
- 4. About 80% are satisfied with the current system of bi-weekly recycling pickups.**

- 5. About 80% are satisfied with the current bi-weekly pick-up of recyclables.**
- 6. About 85% are satisfied with the current weekly pick-up of compostable yard waste in their green carts.**
- 7. About 75% are satisfied with the current front curbside pickup of their household waste and recycling.**
- 8. About 80% are satisfied with the size and design of their grey cart.**
- 9. About 90% are satisfied with the size and design of their green cart.**
- 10. About 30% were willing to pay more for weekly garbage pick-up.**

**11. About 35% are willing to pay more to have kitchen food waste collected in their green cart.**

***NOTE: Almost all citizens who attended the May 10 Open House were in favour of a full organic compost program once the benefits of the full organic program were explained to them.***
