## *Town of Ponoka* *Waste Transfer Station*

### **Hazardous Waste Collection Program:**

- The Town of Ponoka operates a ***year round*** Hazardous Waste Collection Program at its Waste Transfer Station.
  
- The following items are accepted ***at no charge*** through the Town's Hazardous Waste Collection Program:
  - Aerosol cans
  - Paint
  - Household Cleaners
  - Pesticides
  - Fertilizer [must be in original containers]



# **Waste & Recycling Program Public Open House**

## ***Waste Transfer Station (continued)***

### **Other items accepted at the Waste Transfer Station *at no charge:***

- Tires (no rims)
- Branches
- Compostable Material (grass, leaves, plant debris)
- Recyclable Materials (plastics #1 and #2, cardboard, etc.)
- Aerosol cans, Paint, Household Cleaners, Pesticides, Fertilizer [must be in original containers]
- Used Oil (circulating, compressor, engine, gear, hydraulic fluid, transmission fluid, marine engine oil)
- Vehicle batteries



# **Waste & Recycling Program Public Open House**

## ***Waste Transfer Station (continued)***

### **Additional Items Accepted at the Waste Transfer Station**

- Minimum Fee - \$8
- Garbage - \$75 per tonne (includes furniture, drywall, toilets, shingles, non-recyclable plastic)
- Metal - \$25 per tonne (including cable cut in 3' lengths, wire, general scrap, refrigerators, deep freezers)
- Wood - \$10 per tonne
- Concrete and asphalt - \$15 per tonne (must be clean "no garbage")
- Propane Tanks - \$5 each
- Tree Stumps - \$5 each
- Box Spring and/or Mattresses - \$10 each
- Commercial Recycle - \$60 per tonne, \$1.20 per 20 kg

## *Waste Transfer Station (continued)*

### **Materials Not Accepted at Waste Transfer Station:**

- Dead animals
- Bulk liquids and wastes with free liquid
- Radioactive waste
- Industrial waste
- Automobiles or other large metal objects
- Demolition debris
- Hydrocarbon contaminated earth
- Sulfurous waste/soil
- Earth
- Agricultural herbicide/pesticide containers
- Manure
- Large truck or tractor tires
- Asbestos insulation
- Non-lithium and lithium batteries
