Town of Ponoka Property Tax Notices to Be Mailed Out in May

(April 23, 2018 – Ponoka, Alberta) – Town of Ponoka property tax notices will be mailed out to residents during the third of week of May this year, about a month later than in previous years. The deadline date to pay property taxes without penalty has also been moved to July 31, 2018.

Ponoka Town Council voted earlier this year to approve Bylaw 396-18 which moves the property tax deadline to July 31. Bylaw 396-18 also made changes to the property tax penalty schedule.

The property tax penalty that will now be applied to all unpaid taxes after July 31 has been changed to:

August 1	Three per cent (3%) of the current year's unpaid taxes	Changed from 10 per cent
October 1	10 per cent (10%) of the current year's unpaid taxes	Changed from 3 per cent

The penalty on all tax arrears or any portion that remains unpaid after December 31 will remain unchanged at 15 per cent (15%).
