Town Invites Citizen Input on Waste and Recycling Program at Public Open House on May 10

(May 2, 2018 – Ponoka, Alberta) – The Town of Ponoka is inviting public input on its Waste and Recycling Program at a Public Open House being held on Thursday, May 10 at the Kinsmen Community Centre in Ponoka. Members of the public are invited to drop in anytime between 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.

The Open House is part of a program review the Town is currently conducting to gauge citizen satisfaction with Ponoka's curbside Waste and Recycling Program, and to explore and evaluate possible changes to the Program for 2019.

The Open House will be an opportunity for citizens to:

- Browse information displays about the current Waste and Recycling Program and the program review currently underway;
- Fill out a Citizen Input Survey that asks residents to share their thoughts on the current program and what changes they might like to see.
- Ask questions, share comments, and have one-on-one discussions with members of Town Council, Administration and the Recycling Council of Alberta.

The Town's current Waste and Recycling Program contract expires at the end of this year. Citizen input gathered at the Public Open House will be reviewed and considered during the program review as Town Administration and Council determine what possible program changes to consider for 2019.
